


The tile seen here is found around the Nursery fireplace. These tiles were installed during the room's restoration in the 1970s. Their pattern is based on half-tile fragments found when the previous post-WWI-era blue-green tiles were removed. The fragments found are believed to have dated to 1881 when Sam and Livy Clemens were having the hearth constructed. Color your own tile!
